Employee Physical:

This examination gives the employer a valuable base of medical information at a minimum cost. It contains all the components of the pre-placement exam, plus an electrocardiogram with interpretation and a complete blood count.

Fitness for Duty Examination:

Occasionally an employee does not function in a satisfactory manner or performs in a way which may result in injury. An examination may be utilized to assess that employee's physical status and determine ability to perform assigned duties. This evaluation includes a medical history, physical examination, and the specific laboratory tests or x-rays needed to make this determination.





Substance Abuse Testing:

Our medical staff is trained to provide chain of custody collection procedures complying with NIDA requirements for DOT, HRS, and the state of Florida workman's compensation drug-free workplace act. Analysis and confirmations testing is completed by a NIDA certified laboratory.

Medical Review Officer:

Results of substance abuse testing are reviewed by our certified MRO, Dr. Clinton G. Bush. NIDA guidelines are followed to ensure the confidentiality of all results.



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
